Values in the village

The headline of 2012 was undoubtedly the introduction of a new level of stamp duty for properties over £2m. Although much has been reported about a drop in transaction levels between £2m and £4m, we haven't experienced this. In our view the primary reason for transaction levels being lower than expected is over-ambitious pricing. As you would expect in such a marginal market, buyers are doing their research and won't pay over the odds.

We expect much of this year to be just as challenging as last, made even more so with the expected changes to tax structure for properties held in company names. Whilst we predict properties below £1.5m will continue to trade strongly we sense the mid-market will continue to tighten and that sellers will be forced to give serious consideration to their pricing strategies if they want to achieve a timely sale.

As is always the case, quality counts, so if you're planning a sale make sure your property is presented at its very best and ensure you have an agent working tirelessly on your behalf.

French for Fun was born when founder Jessica Bonnard realised that many of the techniques that make language lessons fun for kids could be used for adults too.

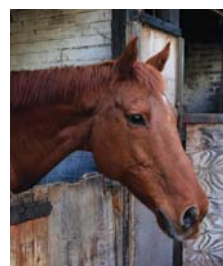
